

Huntington-Surrey Phase Management Covid-19 Response

Huntington Surrey is committed to the safety of our school community and has adopted a planning approach that follows governmental agency directives as well as the guidelines and recommendations from the CDC and the Austin-Travis County Health Authority Public.

We expect we will be shifting across different phases of operations as the year progresses, so maintaining consistency across phases is important to both the staff and student body to ensure seamless transition and low impact to school operations.

During On-Campus operation, phases 1, 2 and 3, parents may choose to have their student work from home instead of on campus based on many factors and especially any underlying health concerns for members of the family. The school will support distance learning for those students as needed.

While it is not possible for Huntington Surrey to provide zero risk of contracting Covid-19, we will strive to maintain some level of in-person schooling as long as it is permitted with operations intended to manage the inherent health risks.

In order to have an on-campus, in-person school experience, students, staff, and parents are required to modify their behavior and interactions and abide by protocols outlined by our phased operations.
